<sup>20</sup> “I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word; <sup>21</sup> **that they may all be one;** even as You, Father, *are* in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me. (John 17:13-21).

When you read the epistles of Paul, its hard to see the importance of unity that is stressed into the text. Almost all of his letters include some type of plea for unity among believers. Paul dedicated his life not only to spreading the gospel to the gentiles but making sure Jewish Christians and Gentile Christians remained “one.” In the text above Jesus is with His apostles, it is moments after the Last Supper and hours before He is arrested. In the final moment before He goes to the garden Jesus prays to the Father. Here at the end of the pray He asks that the ones who believe through their word may be united. The word Jesus is describing is the word of the Apostles. In the text Jesus is praying for unity among the future Christians.

Our world is a world divided and it always has been, factions are nothing new. However, the Church is not a place where such divisions are to occur. It is to be a place of unity and peace. A *renewal* in which there is no *distinction between* Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave and freeman, but Christ is all, and in all. (Colossians 3:11). -Cody B
